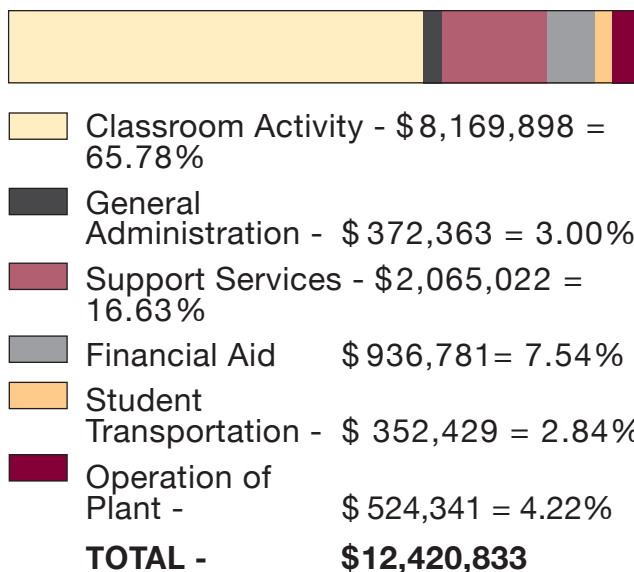

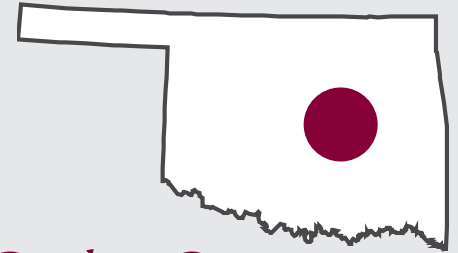
Average wage for year 2017-2018 GCTC graduates: \$15.75 per hour.
